


Our story







GrantNav

A search engine for grants data.

Explore and download data about where funding goes and how much is given across billions of pounds of grants, for causes and locations across the UK.





GrantNav

- Search by keywords <u>"young people"</u>
- Filter searches by date, size, location, programmes, funders and recipients.
- View by <u>grant</u>, <u>funder</u>, <u>recipient</u> or <u>location</u>.
- Download results for further analysis or open view in 360Insights.



360Insights

A tool to help you understand funders better. Combining and visualising 360Giving and charity data. Explore funders across different areas - from their grant dates to types of recipients.

Sir George Martin Trust between 2017 and 2021








360Insights

- View a <u>published file</u> or load in <u>GrantNav search result</u>.
- Combines grants with charity & company data.
- Visualises seven aspects of the data:
 Amounts, Dates, Recipient types,
 Region, Location, Age & Income.



COVID-19 Grants Tracker Launched in April 2020 to track grants awarded in response to the pandemic. Includes grants with "covid", "coronavirus", "pandemic" or "cv19" in the data.


COVID-19 Grants Tracker

- Combines features of GrantNav and 360Insights.
- Filter by <u>funder</u>, <u>recipient</u> or <u>location</u>.
- Shows <u>funding flows</u> between grantmakers.
- Maps a wider range of location data.

Who funds with who?

- Links funders together each thread represents a recipient in common.
- Analysis provides "funders & recipients in common" lists for each publisher.
- Chord diagram analysis can also be filtered by location.

360Giving support for publishing

- Pro-bono support to funders.
- No registration fees.
- Support is tailored to your circumstances.

Process takes time and attention - depending on volume and quality of data.



• 360 Giving 3 steps to sharing data

Plan - Decide and gather the information you want to share.

Prepare - Transform your data into 360Giving format.

Publish - Make the information available online as open data.



Plan

- Which fields to include?
- What time period, programmes?
- How is grants information collected?
- Where is it stored? Is there a grants system?
- Consider privacy/responsible data implications.



Methods for preparing data

- How, what and whether grants information is collected has impact
- Manual vs built-in approaches
- Different options available:
 - Funders with database
 - Funders using spreadsheets, or who don't collect data yet.



Manual approach

- Can work with source data exported from grants system or data managed in spreadsheets.
- Excel Conversion Tool, tailored to each publisher.
- Can be set up for data collection & conversion.



Built-in approach

- CRMs (Salesforce, Microsoft
 Dynamics) can be set up to export
 360Giving data.
- Some 'managed' Salesforce systems have 360Giving already built-in.
- Needs to be configured by Admins or developers/consultants.



Publish

- 1. Decide what open license to use.
- Select a location online to host data.
- 3. Publish 360Giving data file alongside the details of the open license.
- 4. File is added to the 360Giving Data Registry.



360Giving for local authorities

- 360Giving is the grant data standard authorised for use by <u>UK government</u>.
- Sharing 360Giving data fulfills
 Transparency Code 2015 obligations.
- Collating and preparing data has internal benefits - providing a single source of information about funding.



Sir George Martin Trust case study

- Before: Collecting and coding grants manually for internal reporting
- Solution: Set up a simple Excel
 database which works for internal
 purposes and 360Giving data.
- Ongoing process: Filled out after each meeting but published to 360Giving annually.
