What funders collect doesn't always reflect the breadth of what we do. The holistic nature of our work. They mainly want numbers

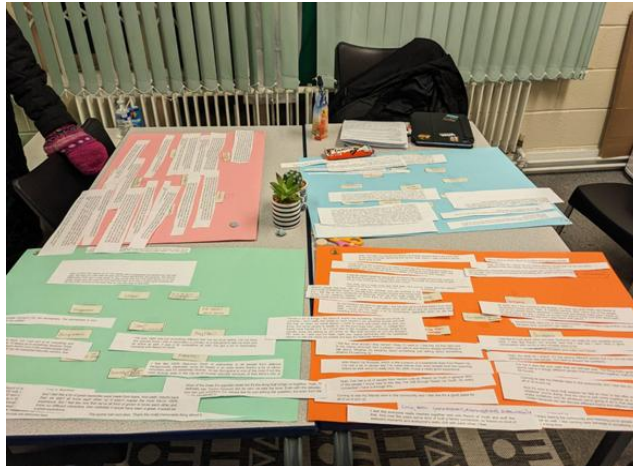
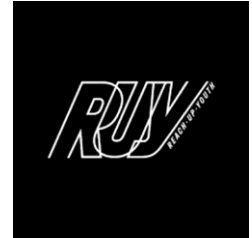
The way funding is set up, encourages inconsistency and competition rather than collaboration and stability
